the Paradise Irrigation District (PID) Options Study.

Learn about the PID water supply system and the Options Study purpose and scope.

What is the PID Options Study: As a result of the Camp Fire in November 2018, Paradise Irrigation District (PID) lost approximately 90% of its connections, making continued water supply operations unsustainable until recovery and rebuilding is completed. To ensure the long-term sustainability and resiliency of the community's water system(s), and to support the community's redevelopment, the community needs to perform an Options Study (Study) to identify and evaluate long-term options for improving its water system infrastructure and finances. This Study is also a mandated requirement to ensure that PID can obtain funding from the California State Legislature for its drinking water system improvements.

The meeting will be held in two parts, with an in-person meet and greet followed by a virtual informational meeting
