

Request for Proposal for Weekly Home Water Delivery

February 6, 2019

This is a Request for a Proposal (RFP) for weekly home water delivery for customers of the Paradise Irrigation District and residents of Paradise California.

Background: The Paradise Irrigation District's (PID) water distribution system was badly damaged as a result of the devastating wildfire that occurred November 8, 2018. PID is unable at this time to deliver potable water to its approximately 1500 homes and businesses left standing in the town of Paradise, Butte County, California. To date, approximately 500 customers approved for occupancy have requested water service.

To better serve the customers of Paradise, PID is seeking requests for proposals for 5-gallon jug water delivery to customer homes with a minimum contract length of 3 months, to be renewed quarterly.

Services to be provided: This RFP is for an external drinking water provider capable of producing and delivering clean drinking water to every standing home or business in the Paradise Irrigation District service area who requests the service.

1. Up to 25 Gallons of drinking water per home / per week in 5-gallon containers.
2. Delivery into the dwelling.
3. Water dispenser.
4. Option for pump dispenser or other smaller delivery options for customers unable to lift 5-gallon containers.
5. Exchange of empty containers on delivery.
6. Method for PID to start and stop services on behalf of customers.
7. Detailed monthly invoice to include delivery confirmation.
8. Delivery to begin ASAP and no later than March 15, 2019.

The response to this RFP should include your company's annual water quality report and current authorization to operate proving you are compliant with any local, federal or state standards established for water quality.

Price List: Your response should include the following price list:

- Include any one-time charges.
- Include price for dispenser.
- Include price for each 5-Gallon container of drinking water.

Submission and Selection: Proposals for the water delivery service must be submitted by February 13, 2019 at 4 pm. PID will review each proposal. Selection of the provider vendor is tentatively set for February 20, 2019.

Other Matters: Please provide references if you have performed this type of mass emergency water supply service before.
