Bids will be reviewed by District staff with the award of contract to be approved by the District Manager or Board of Directors as required by District Procurement Policy.

Bids are to cover all District requirements as specified in this request. The District reserves the right to reject any or all bids or any part thereof.

## DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The work at each site shall be performed in a manner consistent with industry practice and includes but may not be limited to the following details:

- A hard-wired system managed by the video contractor.
- DVR system with web-based capabilities for viewing at each site location.
- Assessment of replacement of existing cameras as necessary.
- The addition or replacement of cameras at front entrances sufficient to identify people entering the building.
- Abilities to assign permissions to delegated reviewers with a minimum of 2 admins.
- Minimum of one week of memory for viewing footage.
- Cameras to be in full color and include night vision.

### Specific Location Needs:

#### Site 1

1. Limited view access at the front counter: A viewing screen with multiple camera views for Customer Service personnel.
2. Front entrance cameras to be high-definition for recognition.

#### Site 2

1. Limited view access on the Standby phone via mobile app.
2. Currently has 16 security cameras, will need up to 20 working cameras total.

3. Parking lot cameras to be high-definition for recognition.

### Site 3

1. Limited view access in the Control Room: A viewing screen with multiple views for Operator personnel.
2. Currently has no cameras, will need up to 12 working cameras.
3. Front entrance cameras to be high-definition for recognition.

### Additional Requirements

1. Qualified Contractor shall possess an active license issued by the California Department of Consumer Affairs, Contractors State License Board.
2. Contractor shall provide a fixed cost to remove current applicable security camera systems at Sites 1 and 2, and install new security camera systems at sites 1, 2 and 3.
3. Contractor shall provide separate bids for Sites, 1, 2 and 3.
4. Contractor shall, to the extent relevant to the service described herein, ensure complete functionality of the needs described per each location prior to project closure.

**Please read this sample letter agreement carefully. Failure of the lowest qualified bidder to supply required business license and certificates of liability insurance within ten days of notice of award may result in award to the second qualified bidder.**
