## PID BACKFLOW MAINTENANCE FORM

**\*If you are new to PID or have a new account, please contact us to discuss your water needs. \***

PID policy requires backflow prevention protection at every service connection as a condition of service. Title 17 of California State water regulations defines backflow prevention device installation and maintenance requirements including specifying the backflow prevention device be tested annually AND anytime the device fails, needs a repair, is moved or replumbed.

Please sign below if you would like PID to take responsibility for your backflow prevention device.

You will be agreeing to PID taking ownership responsibility of the device and maintaining this backflow device for \$60.00 a year, resulting in a \$5.00 per month charge to your water bill. This fee will be evaluated in March of 2022 and possibly adjusted, then re-evaluated at a minimum of every two years.

I attest I am the property owner or authorized agent.

I understand this decision is permanent and PID will take over ownership responsibility of the device and the property owner will be responsible for paying the annual backflow prevention maintenance fee.

I understand this annual maintenance fee is based on PID's cost to administer the program and may be adjusted in the future.

I understand my water use will be metered and I will be charged for the water I use. The water usage rate is \$1.61 per unit (1 unit = 100 cubic feet = 748 gallons). In the case where the water quality advisory has not been lifted from the property, the water use rate will temporarily be charged at \$0.35 per unit (1 unit = 100 cubic feet = 748 gallons).

I understand the PID Board of Directors reserves the right to make changes to the program or backflow policy at any time.
